

TREASURE HUNT



For age group: 6-10

Materials required:

Papers

Pen

Treasure (e.g. chocolate)

Estimated time: 1 hour

Objective:

Develop searching skills

This is the most engaging game you can play with your child. First you need to make an easy map of the house so that your child can understand. Then place an X or mark on the map to denote where the treasure is. Place the treasure, which can be chocolate or anything your child likes, on the denoted place. You then need to make clues (at least 5) and place them at various locations within the house.

Depending on your child's age you can adjust the difficulty of the clues. It is usually done in the form of riddles but you can make your own unique way of making clues. You need to have clue no. 1 with you. Start the game by giving your child the map and clue no. 1.
